New Membership

Recently moved to Hollis he has a professional history in high technology and now runs Begin Family Farm in Hollis. Jeff is interested in becoming involved to learn from others in the ag community help promote agriculture.

Law Property

M. Post stated the Conservation Commission is pursing a conservation easement funding opportunity for land acquisitions from the NRCS. There is a working group established to help pursue the opportunity and C. Quaine and M. Post are Ag Com representatives. T. Hardy suggested the working group reaches out to D. Juneau from FSA to obtain the applicable land maps.

Living With Agriculture

M. Post suggested the Commission features the Stefanowicz property next year. The Lessee provided an update and stated the invasives should be addressed next January, land reclamation is planned for next spring, the upper area drainage is in the works, and a new maple tapper will be on site. An estimated 28 acres should be recovered for planting with the lower areas featuring trails. M. Post stated the goal is to increase awareness for the public on the benefits of the land reclamation and that public access will be available.

Trail Signage

M. Post is coordinating with E. McIntyre to install additional signage to direct the public to the top of the hill on Woodmont West. This will ensure that the public will remain on designated trails with FSMA in mind.
