

What Else Can I Recycle

Where Do I Put It

Hollis has several different recycling areas at our Transfer Station. The following are located around the one-way loop at the Transfer Station.

- **BICYCLES** – Metal Pile
- **SCRAP METAL** - Please do not leave trash or non-metal items in this area. See attendant for separate recycling of precious metals.
- **REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS & DEHUMIDIFIERS** - Drop at area provided. See attendant. Currently no fee.
- **USED OIL** - Leave uncontaminated and in separate containers at area provided IN SHED **NO ANTIFREEZE**
- **CAR (LEAD ACID) BATTERIES** - Leave IN SHED
- **TV's, MONITORS LAPTOPS**– See attendant for fee schedule.
- **TEXTILE BINS** – Around yard as labeled
- **PROPANE TANKS** – See attendant NO FEE
- **TIRES** – See attendant for fee schedule.
- **ASHES** – Drop at area provided.
- **NEWSPAPER** – place in separate bin by mixed paper
- **CELL PHONES & PAGERS** – Includes batteries, chargers and headsets. PUT IN SHED BY OFFICE
- **MIXED PAPER** - Most other papers, except for cardboard, waxed paper, foil, plastic, oil coated or carbon coated paper. Put in container provided. White/office paper will be in a third bin like/near the separate newspaper bin
- **REUSABLE ITEMS** - Items that can be recycled by reuse. Put in area provided. At swap table through lower gate entrance; closes ½ hour before closing, weather allowed.
- **STEEL CANS** – Clean, flattened if possible. Put in container provided. Put cat food cans here also.
- **FOOD SCRAPS** – Put in barrels past office
- **ALUMINUM CANS** – Clean beverage cans, **NO cat food or foil containers!!!** Put in container provided.
- **GLASS** – Clean, all colors,...Bottles only. , **NO procelains, including toilets & sinks, dishes & mirrors NO ceramics. No metal** (light bulbs).
- **PLASTIC** - Clean Clear Plastic bottles only **NO food containers** . Put in container provided.
- **HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES** – Put in container provided in shed. Alkaline batteries are trash.
- **AMERICAN FLAG** – Disposal Box by Flag or in shed in winter.
- **FLUORESCENT BULBS** - Put in container provided in shed
- **TRASH** - Please reduce trash volume by recycling.
- **CARDBOARD & BROWN PAPER BAGS** - Clean, dry and flattened corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags only. Put in container provided. NO waxed, greasy, soiled boxes no pizza boxes.
- **LATEX PAINT** - Must be dry (add kitty litter, sand or air dry), then place in trash.

- **GAMES, PUZZLES, BOOKS, CD'S, RECORDS**- May be placed in Library Area.

ALL DISPOSAL ITEMS MUST ORIGINATE IN HOLLIS

PLEASE SEE ATTENDANT FOR:

Mercury-containing devices
Lead sinkers.both in Shed

- **WE DO NOT ACCEPT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE**
Oil paints, pesticides, gasoline, explosives, etc. Please see attendant for schedule of Nashua Household Hazardous Waste Program
- **ALL ITEMS** should be crushed to save space and transportation costs.

OTHER RECYCLING OPPORTUNITIES

The Stump Dump on Depot Road accepts all yard waste, branches and brush under 5” from Hollis domiciles free of charge. There is a charge for painted wood or other debris from remodeling. Ask attendants at either location for details. **NO commercial haulers. No Stumps.**

Another option for Hollis residents is to set up a backyard compost area. A place in your yard is all that you need. Put all of your yard waste and kitchen trimmings into this pile and with a little care, you will have wonderful compost for your garden.
