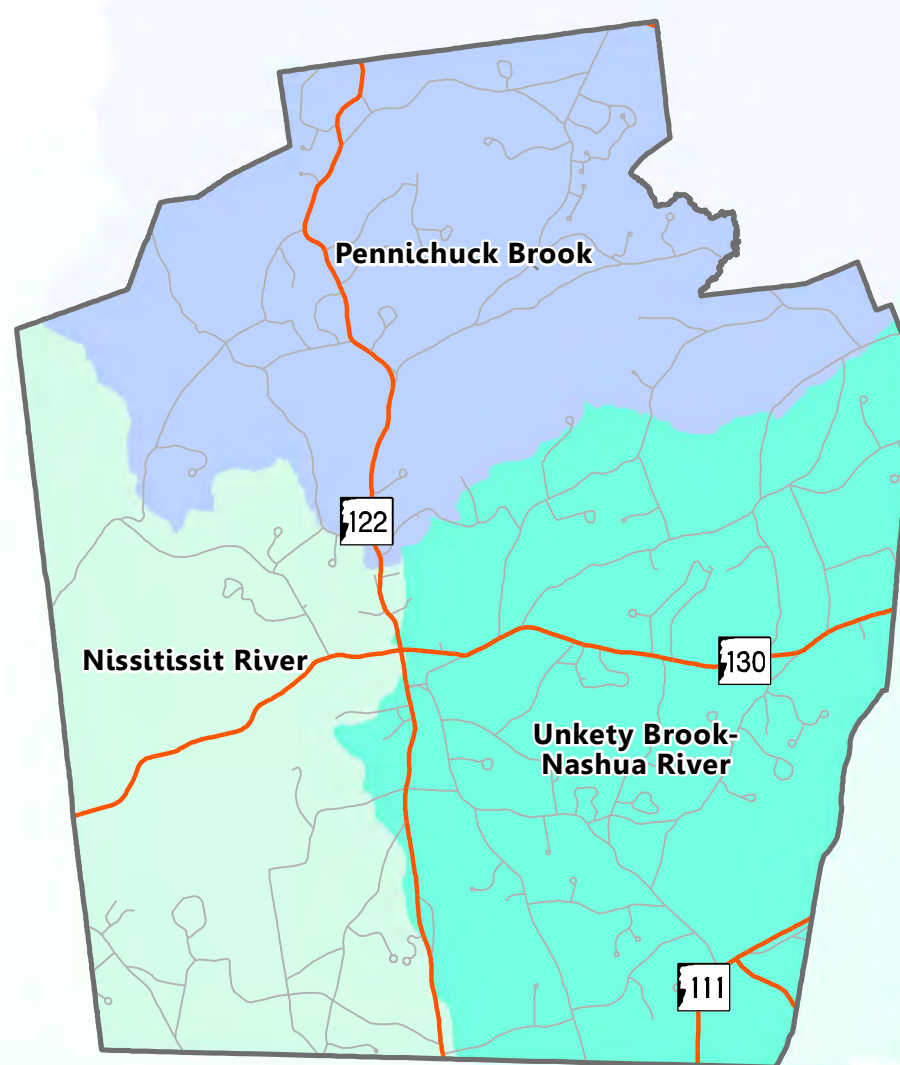


AQUIFERS



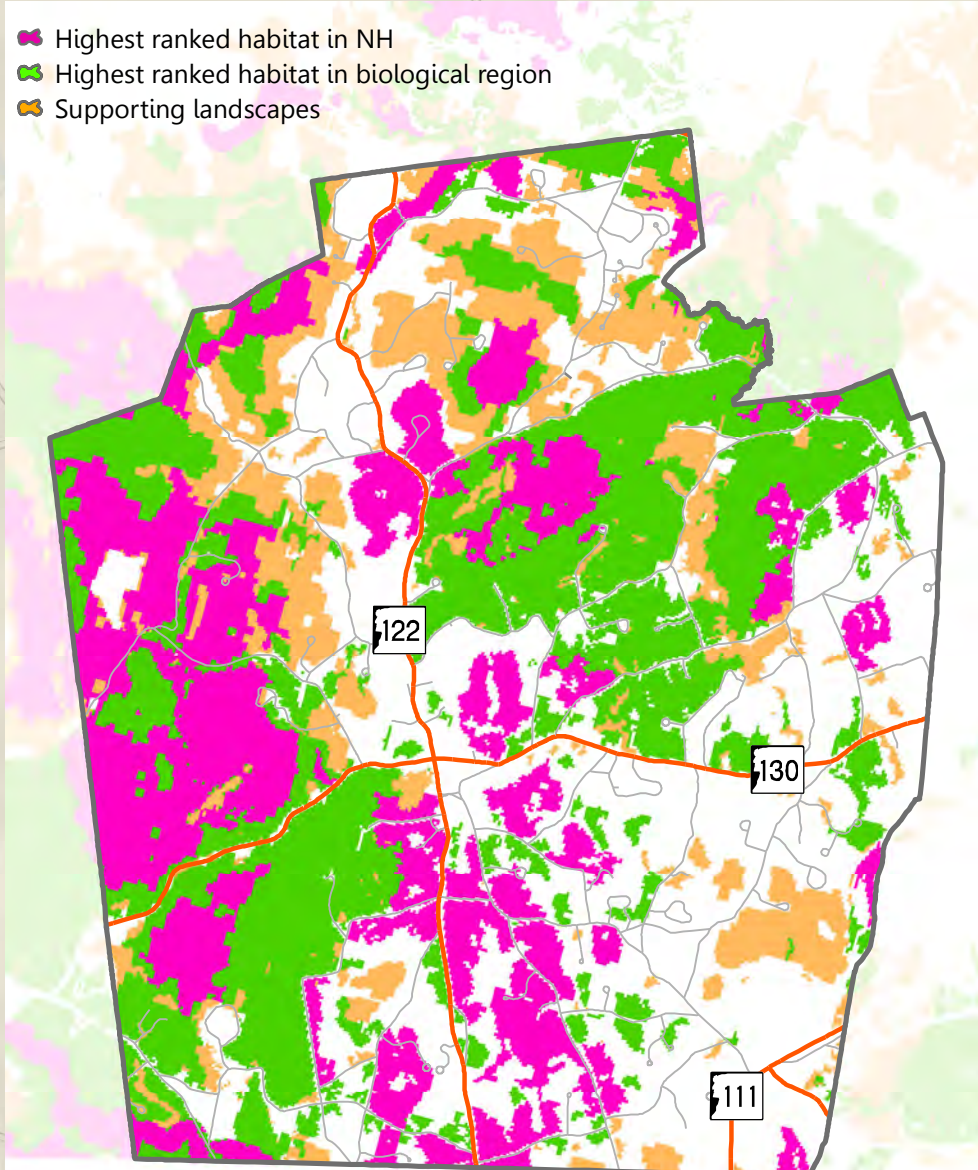

WATERSHEDS



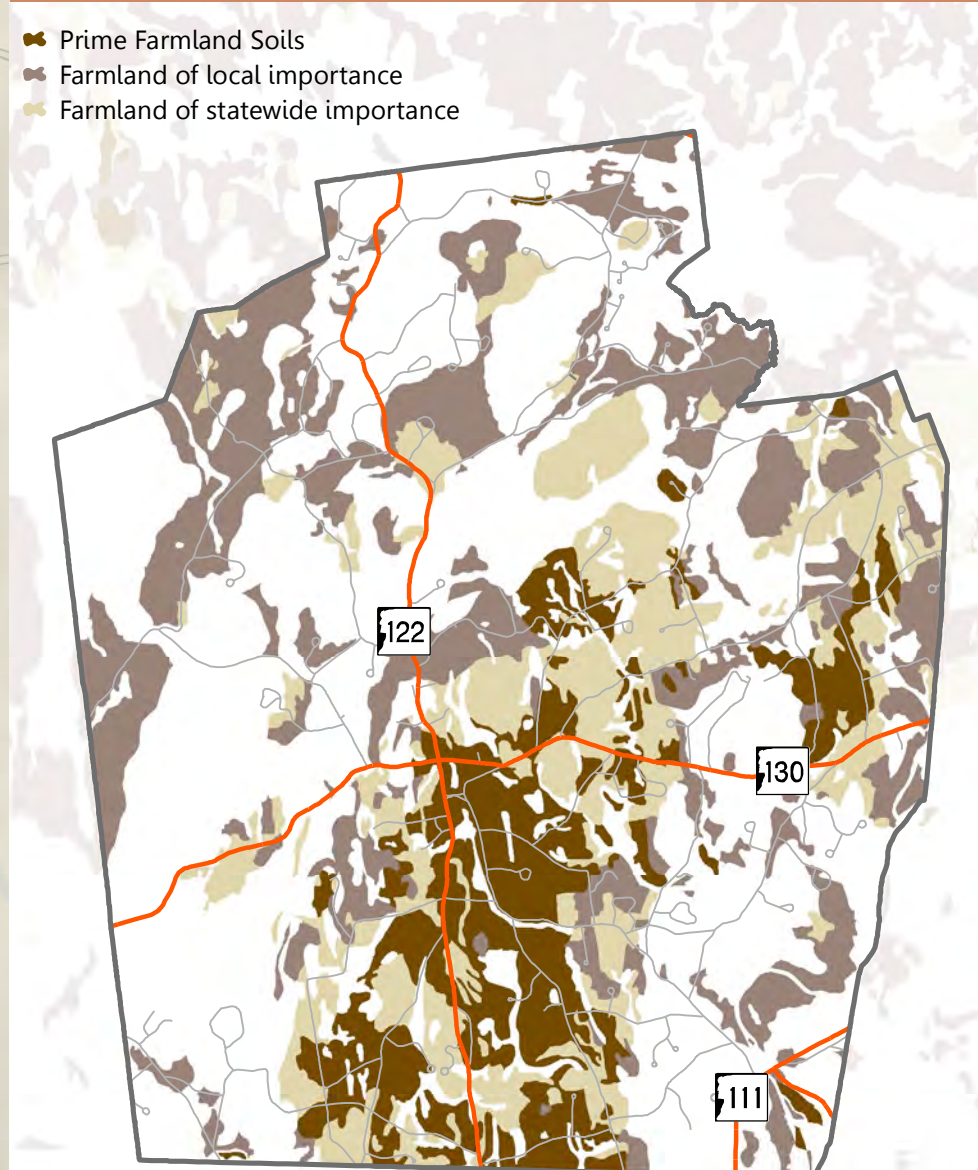
