Hollis Agricultural Commission

Thursday, March 9, 2017

Members in attendance: R. Clark, D. Harmon, C. Husk, D. Petry, A. Pitarys, M. Post

Meeting called to order at 7:35 pm.

- D. Harmon motioned to enter into non-public session, in accordance with RSA 91-A:3, II(d); seconded by R. Clark. All members in favor, none opposed. The motion to enter into non-public session carried 6-0-0, and the Commission entered non-public session at 7:37 pm.
- M. Post motioned to return to public session and to keep the minutes sealed under RSA 91-A:3, III; seconded by R. Clark. All members in favor, none opposed. The motion to return to public session carried 6-0-0, the minutes were sealed, and the Commission returned to public session at 8:35 pm.
- D. Harmon reported that the Woodmont annual review was held. The white barn has been checked by the Town building inspector. While there are some minor siding and cosmetic repairs to be done, the barn is in "good shape." The lessee indicated he still intends to use the building as planned in the future.
- R. Clark reported on the first meeting of a reconstituted Hollis Land Use Board. Consisting of chairs of the various town boards and commissions, the goal is to have quarterly meetings that ensure communication of efforts affecting land use. M. Post noted that the October meeting would be scheduled to allow Planning/Zoning Board early communication of potential changes in regulations being considered. The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 13th June 2017 at 5pm. These are posted meetings open to the public.
- Moved by M. Post and seconded by R. Clark to accept minutes from February 9, 2017 meeting as written; Motion passed 6-0-0.
- Moved by M. Post and seconded by D. Harmon to adjourn. Motion passed 6-0-0, and meeting adjourned at 8:59 pm.
