CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order at 7:34pm.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

I. Unfinished Business

- a. Luminary Event:
 - Rain is in the forecast. Luminaries would be difficult to light and cleanup would be a mess. The Commission agreed to reassess at 10:00am, jointly with K. Harmon, and make a decision as to whether to proceed. The plan would be to meet at Brookdale at 12:00pm. Luminaries would extend from Brookdale, through the center of town, and up Main St.

b. Stefanowicz Update:

- I. DPW placed barricades near the house to prevent access to land from house lot.
- II. Parking area: Joan Cudworth from DPW suggested parking area on next field to south underneath power lines. T. Hardy stated two stone walls interfere with access and this would not be ideal. M. Post suggested the lessee coordinate with DPW to ensure appropriate location of a pullof area for a few cars.
- III. T. Hardy and M. Post stated Town should set markers to ensure town and abutters are aware of exact property Line locations
- IV. Public access: T. Hardy expressed concern over current ATV activity and proposed addressing the issue next spring. M. Post stated current plans by the town were to gate the new access road to prevent all vehicular traffic other than farm operations.
