## CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order at 7:44pm.

## ORDER OF BUSINESS

### Tax Property

Eight acres of town owned land off Broad St may be suitable for agricultural lease. M. Post states that egress to the field may be problematic, and that the four acres of field may be too small for many types of crops. D. Petry stated that there may be easement considerations that would need to be addressed. R. Clark stated that the benefit of Ag use would be to control invasives, and if it were left alone then it may become overgrown. M. Post will discuss easement concerns with C. Cain, in Town Assessing.

### Law Property

M. Post discussed the short-term agreement with L. Radke, and the consensus was that a basic maintenance contract would be the most feasible. Oct 2025 would be soonest that the long-term lease would be effective given the growing season. R. Clark is drafting an agreement to provide to the town as a proposal.

### Woodmont Trail Signs

M. Post spoke to E. McIntyre, the head of the trails committee, about access for large groups. E. McIntyre has trail signs, and that installation should be done in conjunction with the Forest Committee. M. Post suggested that Ag, Trails, and Forest Committee should get together for consensus on installation.
