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2. Recreation Commission - Hardy South Field Update and Contract Approval

progress. He is currently working through the permitting process through the State of New Hampshire for
the wetland area on the South West side of the field. It was reported that the impact is less than 10,000
feet. The area has been surveyed and he is awaiting the plans for the grading. Mr. Gillis requested
