It is understood that all marker and monument work is subject to all the rules of the Cemetery in anyway affecting monuments, markers, headstones or other structures, their manufacture, location, care, installation, removal or in any other regard, subject to all other rules and regulations of the Cemetery now in force or hereafter adopted.				
Should any monument, in the opinion of the DPW Director or Cemetery Trustees become unsightly, dilapidated or dangerous to visitors, it is understood that the Cemetery Trustees shall have the right either to correct the condition or to remove the same at the expense of the lot owner or his heirs, after giving due notice in writing to the last known address of the lot owner on file in the Cemetery Office.				
The undersigned, who represents that he/she/ they is or are the sole and exclusive owners or owners of the Right to Inter (RTI) hereby authorizes and requests the Cemetery Trustees of the Town of Hollis, NH to permit the installation of the marker or monument as described on this application, and the construction of a foundation, if necessary, and does hereby agree to all the terms, conditions and other provisions set forth on both sides of this application.

In the event of this application being signed by an agent of the RTI or deed owner, the agent agrees to inform the RTI or deed owner of the provisions of this agreement and the rules and regulations of the Cemetery governing marker and monument work.				

Monument Dealer Agreement

I certify that I have been authorized by the person making this application, to prepare a marker or monument for the above-described location and that this agreement contains the specifications and detailed sketch of this marker or monument.

I certify that this marker or monument is made entirely of firstgrade material and guaranteed by me to be free from all flaws. Defects and tool marks and that the workmanship on said monument will be of the highest standard. Should a defect in material or workmanship become apparent before the lapse of five years from date of setting, the Director of the Hollis DPW and/or Cemetery Trustees shall make such declaration in writing to the monument dealer and the monument will be replaced without cost to the cemetery.

I hereby agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Hollis Cemeteries now in force or hereafter adopted, in the installation of the marker or monument in the Hollis Cemeteries, and further agree that, if in the opinion of the Director of the DPW or the Cemetery Trustees should the completed marker or monument not comply with said rules and regulations, It will, at the request of the Director of the DPW or Cemetery Trustees, be removed by me within five (5) business days of such request, without cost to the Cemetery or the RTI or Deed Owner.

The undersigned further agrees to hold the Cemetery free from any liability whatsoever for damage to the marker or monument that may result from the installation of said marker or monument, before, during, or after the setting of said monument.

I hereby agree to pay for any damage to lots, graves, walk trees, shrubs, monuments, etc. during the transportation and setting of this marker or monument. I hereby agree to indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Cemetery upon, or from, all claims, demands or alleged causes of action arising by reason of the installation of said marker or monument.

No marker or monument, once installed, may be removed from the Cemetery without the written permission of the Cemetery Trustees.

No Tools, equipment structure, etc., required in the installation of the marker or monument may be left overnight in the Cemetery without the written permission of the Director of the DPW.

Acceptance of this permit by the Cemetery Trustee(s) does not constitute complete approval of this application.
