1. The following message received from Headquarters 2nd Army:-

"ARMISTICE SIGNED EFFECTIVE 11 HOURS 11 NOVEMBER 1918, AT OR BEFORE WHICH TIME ALL HOSTILITIES AND ADVANCE MUST CEASE. HOLD AND ACCURATELY REPORT LINE REACHED AT THAT HOUR. NO COMMUNICATION WILL BE HAD WITH THE ENEMY.

HEINERIMANN CHIEF OF STAFF".

2. Thoroughly explain to all that an armistice is not a peace; and that our status is that of a unit in line of battle in war. All laws and rules of war apply. No change in Brigade orders as to personnel. Improve condition of men and animals; clean equipment, - Keep ready and alert. Enforce paragraph one strictly
