Action Items:

Data Collection at the Schools:

Eric and JW have visited HBMS several times now and flipped off breakers to log what circuits are using major power. They haven't found any big problems and lots of the circuits use expected amounts of power. The BMS system is very difficult to use and only has Occupied/Unoccupied modes. The lighting control system is also antiquated and very difficult to use. Mike will see if there are any plans to upgrade the BMS. Both HBMS and HBHS are good candidates for rooftop solar.

Electric Busses:

Venu discussed the subcommittee meeting with the bus company. Bus miles/hours data is available. The plan of these and the Nashua bus companies is to convert them all to electric by 2035. Venu plans to present to the BOS for 15min on the feasibility study. Lori plans for this to happen on April 26th. Venu will send Lori the slide set this week.

Farley Building:

Lori discussed the most recent committee meeting last night. The committee is investigating grants and looking for an Architect which Mike L is connecting with Dave Ely the architect for the SAU.

State Legislative Issues:

Phil discussed that the community power bill has been changed and is now beneficial to the town. Phil will arrange to have Henry Herndon make a presentation perhaps at the next meeting.
