### **Community Power:**

Henry Herndon (an independent consultant) gave an overview of how Community Power programs are getting started in a number of NH towns (Exeter, Lebanon, Nashua). There were lots of questions so a special meeting will be set up next week to discuss this issue.

## **Transfer Station LED Upgrades:**

Joan has received an LED upgrade quote from Stello's of \$6933 for the transfer station and \$900 for the stump dump. There is a feeling this is high and they will continue looking for other quotes.

#### **Electric Busses:**

Venu indicated his presentation to the BOS about went over quite well. There was even interest in the possibility of electrifying some DPW equipment. He has set up a meeting on May 27th with Joan to discuss the issue.

#### **Farley Building:**

Mike indicated the committee is moving forward to engage an architect to support the NH Preservation Alliance Assessment Grant Program. Dave Ely of Windy Hill Assoc. has submitted a proposal for that effort. A video walk through of the Farley Building has been created and may be available on the town website soon.
