Steve discussed the various activities the subcommittee has undertaken to develop the HEC's ability to get our message out. For the time being they plan to have working meetings half way between the regular HEC meetings.

Old Home Days Preparation:

Steve will be coordinating the OHD prep activities. He is trying to make contact with the OHD Comm to advocate for a good position for the HEC booth on the main street. Mike has applied for a 10x20 ft booth with power. Mike brought in two old banners as samples and will look for any digital files from previous brochures. It was suggested that some sort of solar powered activity be devised to attract folks into our booth.

Community Power:

Philip reviewed the status of the statewide Community Power of NH (CPNH) efforts to get on line. 19 cities and towns have joined so far, representing over 20% of NH's population. The operating rules are still being reviewed by the PUC. CPNH hopes to be able to launch power delivery in the Nov-Dec time frame.

2022 HEC Activity Ideas:

Venu Indicated he would like our next regular meeting to review and discuss the HEC visions we have recently provided him. The goal will be to refine these into a set of activities we can pursue in the near and longer term.
