HB Coop Energy Projects:

Mike spoke to the Coop Board about any existing capital development plans they have. They have just engaged Energy Efficient Investments in Merrimack to review the Coop's capital needs and help develop a Capital Investment Plan (CIP). They will share that data with HEC as it becomes available.

Energy Workshops:

Phillip indicated that town resident Bob Feder is submitting a petition warrant article about having Hollis join a community power group. Phillip will contact Bob about the details of his petition warrant and to see if he would be interested in doing an informational meeting at Lawerance Barn early next year to inform residents about it.

Town Hall Energy Audit:

Paul Armstrong indicated he has spoken to other selectmen about the recent Town Hall EverSource Energy Audit recommendations. He subsequently attended a meeting with maintenance personnel at Town Hall. A plan is being put together to repair the 5 broken zone valves and to install floor insulation per the audit recommendations.
