#### **Community Power:**

Joe Garruba presented the Committee with a letter from the Selectboard asking for answers to questions brought up in earlier meetings with CPCNH and HEC. Steve will ask our CPCNH contact for help in providing answers. We are also waiting for a response for the town lawyer on any issues he sees in the Joint Powers Agreement that the Selectboard has been asked to sign.

#### **COOP Energy Upgrade Plans:**

Steve indicated he has spoken to Andy Cory and it looks like given the current time and budget constraints the COOP will not pursue an energy upgrade bond this cycle. Probably a minimal fix of some kind for the oil pipe issue in March 2024 and a bond for energy upgrades in March 2025. An independent consultant Dave Ely (Windy Hill Associates) has been hired to help the CFC with it's planning. Andy Cory has passed Steve's white paper on to Dave and told Steve he will keep the HEC notified of their progress.

In further discussion HEC members agreed to proceed proactively to support solar and related heating upgrades for the COOP by developing information on the potential energy and cost savings that they could take advantage of.

Steve and Mike will keep in touch with the CFC going forward.
