Following the walk through the committee met for 15 minutes to discuss the following:

Contacting Primex to see if they would conduct an asbestos and lead testing throughout the building. Contacting the NH Preservation Alliance regarding the LCHP grant and other funding options. Contacting Lisa Stasser, a historic structural engineer, to get more information on the building's integrity.

Kevin Anderson mentioned he did some research at the registry of deeds and found nothing tying the building to requiring an educational component. He did find out that the land was owned by a Farley—but not Mary Farley. It was left to her by the original Farley.

There was a discussion about putting together a Historic Charrette to review possible uses.

The committee discussed meeting with the SAU to get a better idea of their needs and space requirements.

The committee agreed that the next step is to focus on a use and define square footage and space needs.
