Hollis Heritage Commission Calendar Guidelines.

The Commission is seeking your favorite photo to include in this year's edition of Scenic Hollis. The calendar will have a seasonally appropriate content chosen from all submitted photos.

These are guidelines for submission:

- The subject/scene must be in Hollis and be identified in the initial submission.
- The photographer may be professional or amateur and need not reside in Hollis.
- Color images are preferred.
- Image size must be capable of being rendered to 9" by 12" **landscape** mode at 300ppi. **Note:** newer cell phone images may be adequate.
- Image file formats should be .jpeg or .png (no .pdf files).
- Image filenames must be labeled with your LastFirst name (e.g.,DoeJohn.jpg). If submitting more than one, add a number to the filename (e.g.,DoeJohn2.jpg).
- The maximum number of submissions per person is 3.
- The image can have no watermarks, borders, or collage composition.
- Subject matter for the photos can be natural views, buildings, flora and fauna from our town. Photos cannot include people.
- The image must be an accurate reflection of the subject matter and scene as it appears, without artistic alteration. Standard image optimization, including removal of dust, cropping, adjustments to color and contrast are accepted.
- If your photo is selected, you will be notified by email and asked to complete a
 submission and release form. By signing the submission form, you give the
 Heritage Commission the right to print the image on the calendar and secure all
 profits from sale of the calendars. You remain the owner of the photo and may
 continue to use it in any manner you choose. You agree that the image(s) you
 submit may be used in the calendar and any promotion of that product.

The annual calendar project is the sole fundraising activity by the Heritage Commission for the purpose of promoting and maintaining the Heritage projects in our town. We look forward to receiving your photos.
