<u>Finance:</u> Averill House is giving the Heritage Commission a generous donation of \$92.50. Jan sent a finance report to Wendy: we have \$26,077.48 in our checking account, which includes \$22,555.48 in the Cooper Shop Fund and \$3,522.00 in the general Heritage Fund. Expenses: \$125 for half of the working cooper demonstration at Old Home Days, and \$128 for Drive-It Day signs. Donations: \$183.00 collected at Drive-It Day.

<u>Calendar:</u> Photos have been finalized, and sponsorship for all months except June have been sold, thanks to the tremendous effort by Honi, Jan, Karla, and Wendy! We have also collected business cards, for smaller advertisements, and have only one space left. (Full month sponsorship = \$400, and includes a business card on the back; business card only, for inclusion = \$200.) The calendars will have to be printed by the 14<sup>th</sup> of September to have them ready for Old Home Days, so we are planning to move up our August meeting to August 14<sup>th</sup>: we will have the regular meeting then, and also proof the calendar and plan for Old Home Days.

<u>Business:</u> The HHC's Vintage Car Drive-It Day received a beautiful write-up by Loretta Jackson in the Hollis-Brookline local newspaper. Karla will send Carl Hill a thank-you note for the tour of Kimball Farms' hydroponic gardens.

Honi reported that the Old Home Days planning is coming along. They are still trying to decide what to do for food; it doesn't look as if there will be chicken dinners this year.

There have been no building demolitions to record.

Frank reported on the Selectmen's recent meeting.

The subcommittee for signage at Woodmont has been doing editing and preparation. We will have drafts for viewing at Old Home Days.

Dave mentioned that we are having an appraisal of the donated antique sleigh done. Frank has asked the Selectmen if we can store it in the loft at the Lawrence Barn.
