Minutes of the February 3, 2022 Meeting**

Call to Order

T. Cook called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

The application of Frank Teas, Millyard Bank, to install a temporary business sign, property owned by MHA Corp., located at 9 Ash Street (Map 052, Lot 041) in the Town Center Zone.

Frank Teas approached the board on behalf of the Millyard Bank to give an explanation of the temporary sign that would be placed on the property. P. Jones asked how long the temporary sign would be up, F. Teas answered that the tentative open date of the bank would be April 15, 2022 and that the temporary sign would come down to make way for the permanent signs once opened.

The application of Frank Teas, Millyard Banks, to install 4 new business signs, property owned by MHA Corp., located at 9 Ash Street (Map 052, Lot 041) in the Town Center Zone.

F. Teas thanked D. Setaro for all her help with the application process. F. Teas described the permanent signs that would be placed on the building and the marquee sign. The marquee sign will be illuminated by the existent floodlight. The contents of the sign are as follows:

1. Phone number 603-465-6500
2. Logo and tagline
3. Blue and Red coloring

There will be three directional signs, that were already existent from when Santander was on the premises. The front door, drive up side of the building, and back door that will have information including the hours the bank will be open.
