Call to Order

The application of Joel and Tanya Rasmussen, property owners, to install 14 replacement windows, located at 16 Depot Rd. (Map 051, Lot 004) in the Town Center District.

Joel Rasmussen stated the home was built in 1978 and has the original windows which are leaking to the point you can see in the home. The proposal is to replace 14 original wood windows with Marvin wood interior and aluminum-clad outside with true-divided-light. All of the replacement windows would be the same size and have the same grid pattern as the existing windows.

- T. Cook asked if they would keep the same grid of windows on the house.
- J. Rasmussen stated that they would be maintaining the same grid pattern of windows on the house. Across the front there would be eight over twelve on the top, twelve over twelve on the bottom floor. From the street it would look the same as it does now.

Discussion took place on future replacements of the windows in the back and the application process.
