Welcome

Chair Status Update

- Electrical Upgrades (Jayrards Java Café) We will not be able to support the electrical requirements for this vendor. Judy will get back with him.
- Cow Patty Bingo The HS robotics team is interested in taking over the cow patty bingo. The committee felt that they should make it their own and not need to duplicate the way it was done in the past. They should submit an application.
- PA system is all set. Will be done same as last year.
- Finalizing the ATM contract for Friday and Saturday. Police want to make sure no cash is let at the field at the end of the night,

- The Hollis Congregational Church will have a pancake breakfast morning of OHD. Holly explain that it would not be an OHD sponsored event. Breakfast needs to be over by 10:00.
- Over 90's Holly will make vouchers similar to last year. Closer to event we will select which food vendors will participate in the "Free over 90's lunch".
- Nate (the committee) is required to submit a request to the town for a permit to hold Old Home Days. Nate will prepare the paperwork.
- We discussed the need/location for the signs. Looking for committee volunteers to help but them out in specific locations.
- Parking, Nate has worked out with Knight of Columbus to do our parking. They
 are asking for a \$1,000 donation. Anne Marie made a motion to pay the K of C
 \$1,000 for parking services. Pending final approval from K of C. Judy seconded
 the motion. The vote was unanimous to accept. The process should be
 discussed with Barbara.
