## HOLLIS PLANNING BOARD SITE WALK NOTES SATURDAY, December 4, 2021 Final

The Planning Board convened on Saturday December 4, 2021 at 8:30 AM to conduct a site walk for the proposed 3 lot subdivision of 29-4 Lorenzo Lane.

<u>File PB2021:022</u> – Proposed amendment to the approved Federal Hills Estates HOSPD (Keyes Road) subdivision, by attaching a minor subdivision of an adjoining 18.7 acre property into three lots (Lots sizes ranging from 5 – 7.8 acres) through the extension of Lorenzo Lane, in addition a lot line relocation will occur with an adjoining property, Owner: C.W. Rev. Lvg. Trust & Raisanen Homes Elite, LLC – Applicant: Raisanen Homes Elite, LLC, Map 29 Lot 1, 1-17,2 & 4, Zoned Rural and R&A.

Chair Bill Moseley reviewed the procedural rules regarding site walks; specifically that a site walk is a public meeting and the public is welcome to attend, but no public input is allowed.

- C. Branon began by orienting the site walk participants. He pointed out stakes showing the center line of the road extension and where the new open space will be.
- B. Moseley asked about the location of wetlands.
- E. Clements asked which station the hammerhead began at.
  - C. Branon responded that it began at station 10.50.
- B. Moseley asked if there was anything out of the ordinary with the proposed septic systems.
  - C. Branon stated that anticipated traditional septic systems.
- B. Moseley and D. Cleveland discussed the proposed culvert for the wetland crossing on Lot 2.
  - C. Branon estimated a 24" culvert would be used.
- C. Branon pointed out a leg of existing trail that would be relocated. General discussion followed.
  - K. Anderson asked about where the trail will be relocated too.
  - C. Branon responded that the trail would be relocated along the powerline easement.

The site walk concluded at approx. 9:32 AM.
