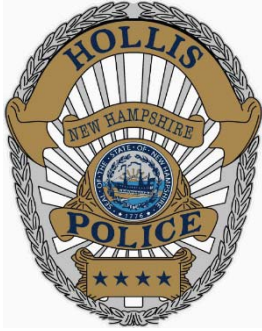

On January 20, 2020, Hollis Officers were dispatched to Brown Ln. for a report of a subject firing a handgun from a vehicle. Officers located the vehicle in question on Main St, where they followed it onto Silver Lake Rd and initiated a motor vehicle stop. The subsequent investigation revealed that the driver, Jamison Mendall, 26, of Hollis, had stopped on Brown Lane and shot a fox that he perceived to be sick, he shot the animal from inside his vehicle, and within close proximity to a residence. On January 24, 2020, Mendall turned himself in to the Hollis Police on a warrant charging him with Reckless Conduct and Disorderly Conduct. Mendall was released on Personal Recognizance bail with an arraignment date of March 18, 2020 at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District.

NH Fish and Game Officers are also investigating this incident.
