On July 10, 2019, members of The Hollis Police and Hollis Fire Departments were dispatched to a residence on Apple Lane for a reported assault, whereby two individuals had been injured. Upon arrival of first responders, it was determined that the injured parties, an adult male and adult female, had been assaulted by a family member, Todd McNulty, age 34. After the assault, McNulty fled into the nearby woods. Hollis Police were assisted by several agencies in the search for McNulty, including the Brookline, Milford, and Mason Police Departments, as well as the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office. McNulty was ultimately located on the property of a nearby home on Rocky Pond Road where he was arrested and taken into custody without further incident.

Both victims were initially treated at St. Joseph's Hospital in Nashua but due to the extent of the female victim's injuries she was later transported to Lahey Clinic in Massachusetts. As a result of the attack, she sustained broken ribs and broken vertebrae, along with other minor injuries.

McNulty is charged with numerous counts of Domestic Violence related Simple Assault charges (Class A Misdemeanors), and two counts of Domestic Violence related 2nd Degree Assault, (Felony). He was held without bail at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections and was arraigned on July 11, 2019, in the Hillsborough County Superior Court South.
