On August 14th, 2021, a Hollis Patrol Officer made a motor vehicle stop for a speeding violation. The driver produced identification, and upon running the information on that license, learned that the driver had a warrant for her arrest by the Salem Police Department. She was taken into custody, processed, and released with an arraignment date for Salem. Hollis Police continued an investigation, which resulted in a warrant being issued for various drug offenses, as the driver had prescription drugs in her possession that she was unable to prove were legally prescribed to her.

On March 5. 2022, the Hollis Police Department was contacted by the Salem, NH Police Department in regards to this incident. It was determined through an unrelated investigation of theirs that the woman mentioned above had provided false identification when she was arrested in August. She was ultimately identified as Lisa Dasilva, 54, of Braintree Mass. As a result of this information, an arrest warrant was drafted, and Dasilva was arrested on March 7, 2022. She was processed and released on cash bail with an arraignment date to be determined at the Hillsborough County Superior Court, Southern District.

Dasilva is charged with Identify Fraud (Felony), 3 counts of Possession of a Controlled Drug (Felonies), 3 counts of Transportation of a Controlled Drug (Misdemeanors), Disobeying an Officer (Misdemeanor), and Dealing/Possessing Prescription Drugs (Misdemeanor). The arrest warrant that had originally been issued under the falsely provided name has been been vacated.
