On September 23, 2023, at approximately, a Hollis Police Officer observed a pickup truck traveling on east Broad St that did not have an inspection sticker or a front license plate (both are violations of NH statute). The officer attempted to conduct a motor vehicle stop. Upon activating his emergency lights, the vehicle accelerated rapidly, and crossed the center line to pass several other vehicles. The vehicle reached speeds estimated to be approximately 90 miles per hour.

Due to the amount of traffic on the roadways and the manner in which the truck was driving, the officer used sound judgment in discontinuing pursuit, as continuing to pursue would have created a greater danger to the public.

A short time later, Hollis officers were notified by the Nashua Police Department that the pick up truck was found abandoned on a side road in their jurisdiction. After a lengthy investigation, officers were able to determine that the truck has just been purchased in a private sale in Brookline. The purchaser, later identified as Matthew Jordan, 39, of Nashua, affixed a stolen license plate to the truck and drove it from the point of sale.

Officers were granted an arrest warrant for Jordan on September 28, 2023. At the time of issuance, Jordan was being held at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections on a probation violation stemming from this incident. Officers took custody of Jordan at the House of Corrections and transported him to the Hollis Police Department for processing. He was subsequently transported back to the House of Corrections to await his first court appearance.

Jordan is charged with Reckless Conduct (Felony B), Habitual Offender (Felony B), Disobeying an Officer (Misdemeanor A), Driving After Revocation, subsequent (Misdemeanor A), Receiving Stolen Property (Misdemeanor A), Failure to Display Plates (violation), Uninspected Vehicle (violation), Misuse of Plates (violation), and License Required (violation). At the time of this press release, Jordan is still housed at the Hillsborough County House of Corrections.
