

On March 10, 2021, at around 9:00 PM, members of the Hollis Police and Fire Departments were notified of a motor vehicle accident in the area of Wood Lane and Apple Lane. This was reported by a resident in the area who heard the collision and later observed the vehicle involved traveling on Apple Lane. Officers ultimately located the vehicle involved parked in front of one of the condominiums with a male seated in the passenger seat. After speaking with the male it was determined that he was impaired. As a result, Jed Darling, age 49 of Hollis was placed under arrest and charged with Driving Under the Influence, a Class B Misdemeanor.

On March 12, 2021, at approximately 7:00 PM, Officer Nicholas Collishaw observed a vehicle traveling on Route 111 in an erratic manner. Upon making a motor vehicle stop and speaking with the driver, it was determined that he was operating a vehicle while impaired. A records check through the Department of Motor Vehicles indicated that the driver's license was currently suspended for a prior DUI conviction. As a result, Michael Charron, age 24 of Nashua was placed under arrest. He is charged with Driving Under the Influence, a Class B Misdemeanor, DUI 2nd Offense, a Class A Misdemeanor, Operating After Suspension, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Lane Control, a Violation.

On March 13, 2021, at 2:30 AM, members of the Hollis Police and Fire Departments were dispatched to the area of The Timber Post Bed and Breakfast on Broad Street for a motor vehicle accident. It was determined that vehicle had been traveling west on Broad Street when it left the roadway and struck a mailbox and several bushes before continuing westbound. A short time later the vehicle was located a short distance away on Broad Street. After speaking with a male, who identified himself as the operator, Matthew Tomer, age 33 of Hollis, he was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence, a Class B Misdemeanor, DUI 2nd Offense, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Criminal Mischief, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Under NH state law, a conviction for 2nd Offense DUI or Operating Under the Influence (DUI) both carry mandatory jail sentences. All individuals taken into custody were released on PR Bail with arraignment dates in the 9th Circuit Court Nashua District on April 22, 2021.
