The Hollis Police patrol division had a busy weekend (May 5-May 8). In addition to handling their normal call volumes, patrol officers made the following arrests:

May 5, approximately 8:00 PM: Hollis officers responded to Nichol's Field for a report of a suspicious activity. Upon arrival, they made contact with the driver of a Dodge Challenger in the parking lot. After speaking with the driver, officers observed signs of impairment and began a roadside investigation. Subsequently, Tiffany Smith, 34, of Hollis was arrested and charged with DUI-Aggravated, and DUI- Impairment. The Aggravated charge stems form the fact that at the time of the alleged offense, she had a passenger under the age of 16 in the vehicle.

May 6, approximately 12:30 AM: Hollis officers made a motor vehicle stop for a speeding violation on Route 111. The operator, identified as Lindsey Randlett, 34, of Litchfield NH was arrested and charged with Suspension of Registration of Vehicle, Lic. Required; Op w/Expired License, and Driving After Revocation/Suspension.

May 6, approximately 7:45 PM: Patrol Officers received a report of erratic operation on Broad St. After locating the vehicle in question, officers independently observed it cross the center line multiple times. Officers initiated a motor vehicle stop and determined that the operator was impaired. Ryan Macdonald, 39, of Hudson NH was arrested and charged with DUI as well as a yellow line violation.

May 7, approximately 2:30 AM. The Londonderry Police Department contacted Hollis officers to report that they had taken a subject into custody based on an arrest warrant issued to Hollis officers August 4, 2017. Hollis officers responded to Londonderry where they took James Sylvia, 35, of Chelmsford MA into custody. Sylvia is charged with Possession of a Controlled Drug (Felony) as a result of the investigation from 2017.

May 7, approximately 1:45 PM: Officers received a report of erratic operation on Depot Rd. They located the vehicle in question on Richardson Rd. After conducting a brief investigation, Heidi Proctor, 55, of Hollis was arrested and charged with DUI.

All subjects listed above were processed and released on personal recognizance with arraignments scheduled at either the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District, or Hillsborough County Superior Cort, Southern District.
