On October 10, 2022, at approximately 12:20 in the afternoon, Officer Michael Trapani conducted a motor vehicle stop for a yellow line violation on Pepperell Rd (Rt 122). Upon making contact with the driver, he immediately noticed signs of impairment. Following a road side investigation, the operator was placed under arrest. Helena Pisetsky, 55, of Billerica Ma, was transported to the HPD for processing. She was released on PR bail with an arraignment date in the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District.

It is believed that there were witnesses to Pisetsky's erratic driving prior to the motor vehicle stop. Anyone who may have witnessed erratic driving on Rt 122 on October 10th is asked to contact Officer Trapani at 603-465-7637.

Impaired driving offenses continue to be a serious problem on our roadways. To date, we have seen an 80% increase in DUI arrests this year when compared to the same time period in 2021.
