On May 20, 2023, an Orchard Drive resident reported her pet kitten had been stolen. The reporting party provided photographic evidence of the incident, which allegedly occurred on May 12, 2023. Officers were able to gather enough evidence to identify a suspect and determine that there was sufficient probable cause to move forward with charges. Officers prepared an arrest warrant, and on June 12, 2023, Jennifer Radcliffe, 34, of Wilton NH turned herself into the Hollis Police Department.

Radcliffe was processed and released on PR bail with an arraignment date set at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District. She is charged with two counts of Theft by Unauthorized Taking (both class A misdemeanors).

At the time of this press release, "Helen" (the kitten in the attached photo) has not been located. It is believed that Helen was most likely given to an unknown third party.
