#### **\*\*\*\*\*UPDATE\*\*\*\*\***

A second arrest has been made in connection with this incident. On 5/3/22, at approximately 8:15 AM, members of the Nashua Police Department arrested Isaac Acorn, 18, of Nashua pursuant to an arrest warrant issued to Hollis Police Department. Hollis Officers transported Acorn to the HPD for processing. He was released on cash bail with an arraignment date at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District. He is charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Minor. He was a passenger in the vehicle at the time of the incident listed below, and violated his duty to care for the unrestrained 6 month old child that was in the car.

#### **\*\*\*\*\*END OF UPDATE\*\*\*\*\***

On April 23, 2022, at approximately 1:20 PM, a Hollis officer made a motor vehicle stop for a speeding violation on Rideout Rd. After further discussion, it was discovered that a six month old child was in the backseat of the vehicle, unrestrained.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, the driver, identified as Alyiah Brown, 18, of Nashua, was taken into custody. She is charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Minor, Operating Without a Valid License, Speeding, and Child Restraints Required. Additional charges may be forthcoming. She was transported to the Hollis Police Department for processing and was released on PR bail with an arraignment date at the 9th Circuit Court, Nashua District.
