MOTION by Dave Belanger to accept the 4/3/19 minutes as written, 2nd by Russ Rogers.

ACCEPTED

Fields: Looking at 50 parking spaces. Met with the equestrian group. They are willing to move the horse ring. The trust for the horse ring at Nichols field, can't touch the trust if the horse ring moves. Dirt and footing moves with the ring. Presented the DPW property and Stefanowicz property. Will need water and electricity.

Brian and Dave attended the selectmen's meeting. They will not support Stefanowicz for fields or horses.

The selectmen do support the DPW site. The land can tie into the trail system.

Conservation does not support Stefanowicz.

Need to talk to Meridian on how high the land at Stefanowicz needs to be raised to keep it dry.

Will have Meridian outline the DPW and Stefanowicz for fields and the relocated horse ring.

Spoke to a hydrologist from North East Geo-Studies. HBHS and DPW water sources will be investigated. Can cost approximately \$3,000.00 per study.

Brian will check to see what water studies have already been done at HBHS.

Need to nail down some numbers.

Correspondence: Waiting for reply from the summer dance class request. Have not had a response from the sand volley ball request.

Hardy South: Trees are dying. Travis Spaulding believes the trees are drowning. Suggested a berm and then replant up out of the water. The cost will be \$3,600.00 to redo the field buffer.

MOTION by Dave Belanger not to exceed \$3,700.00 to redo the field buffer at Hardy South, 2nd by Russ Rogers.
