What Else Can I Recycle? Where Do I Put It?

Hollis has several different recycling areas at our Transfer Station. The following are located around the one-way loop at the Transfer Station.

Scrap Metal Area

- SCRAP METAL Please do not leave trash or non-metal items in this area. See attendant for separate recycling of precious metals.
- REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, AIR CONDITIONERS & DEHUMIDIFIERS Drop at area provided.
- USED OIL- Leave uncontaminated and in separate containers at area provided. Do not pour out, if you need the container back, please see attendant.
- **COOKING OIL-** Leave container in the shopping cart. Must be in liquid form.
- TV's, MONITORS & LAPTOPS—See attendant for fee schedule.
- **PROPANE TANKS** - Leave at area provided
- TIRES See attendant for fee schedule

In The Gray Shed That Says Recycling Saves Tax Dollars

- CAR (LEAD ACID) BATTERIES Leave on the pallet.
- HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES Put in container provided. Alkaline's are safe to throw in the trash
- **AMERICAN FLAG** Disposal Box.
- CELL PHONES & PAGERS Includes batteries, chargers and headsets.
- LAPTOP BATTERIES- Put in the container provided.
- **SALVATION ARMY** –Used clothing only. Put in container provided. Clean, dry, in plastic bags. NO soiled materials, rugs, pillows, socks, underwear.

Newspaper Area

- **ASHES** Drop at area provided.
- **NEWSPAPER, NO MAGAZINES** NO soiled papers, strings plastic or paper bags, junk mail, tissue, office paper, carbon paper or any sort of gift paper. Magazine in mix paper.
- MIXED PAPER Most other papers, magazines, except for cardboard, waxed paper, foil, plastic, oil coated, carbon coated paper, or wrapping paper. Put in container provided.
- WHITE PAPER ONLY- Put in container provided.
 Recycling Area
- FLUORESCENT BULBS Put in containers next to the library
- LIBRARY- Books, Games, Puzzles, CD's and Records may be placed in this area.
- TRANSLUCENT JUGS- Clean, put in container provided.
- PLASTIC Clean plastic food containers Put in container provided.
- ALUMINUM CANS & TIN FOIL Clean beverage cans, cat food cans & tin foil goes into the trash cans by the aluminum. Put in container provided.

- GLASS Clean, all colors, no caps bottles and jars only, no metal (light bulbs) ceramics, porcelain- including toilets & sinks, dishes & mirrors, windshields.
- Food Composting- Only vegetable scrapes collected in designated area.
- STEEL CANS Clean, flattened. Put in container provided.

STILL GOOD - Items that can be recycled by reuse. Put in area provided.

- TRASH Please reduce trash volume by recycling.
- CARDBOARD & BROWN PAPER BAGS Clean, dry and flattened corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags only. Put in container provided. NO waxed, greasy, soiled boxes.
- LATEX PAINT Should be dry (add kitty litter, sand or air dry), then place in trash.

ALL DISPOSAL ITEMS MUST ORIGINATE IN HOLLIS

PLEASE SEE ATTENDANT FOR:

Mercury-containing devices Lead sinkers.

- WE DO NOT ACCEPT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE
 Oil paints, pesticides, gasoline, explosives, etc. Please see attendant for
 schedule of Nashua Household Hazardous Waste Program
- ALL ITEMS should be crushed to save space and transportation costs.

OTHER RECYCLING OPPORTUNITIES

The Stump Dump on Depot Road accepts all yard waste, branches and stumps from Hollis domiciles free of charge. There is a charge for painted wood or other debris from remodeling. Ask attendants at either location for details. Commercial haulers may be subject to fees.

Another option for Hollis's residents is to set up a backyard compost area. A place in your yard is all that you need. Put all of your yard waste and kitchen trimmings (avoid meat as it will attract animals) into this pile and with a little care, you will have wonderful compost for your garden.
